

Requirements for reporting documentation of practice

“Work practice (general medicine practice (assistant physician at an outpatient clinic))” for students admitted in 2022 in the educational program

31.05.01 General Medicine, specialization (profile) General Medicine

(Specialist degree program), full-time mode of study

for the 2026-2027 academic year

Practice reporting forms:

- practice diary

The practice diary should include:

- 1) Individual practice assignment.

The last sheet of the individual assignment is signed:

- Student,
 - Head of practice from a medical organization,
 - Head of practice from an educational organization (Department of Outpatient and Emergency Medicine)
- 2) Student's occupational safety briefing checklist
 - 3) Chronological protocols of various types of work performed by the student during the internship.

Protocols are drawn up for each day of the work practice. In the entries in the chronological protocols, it should be clearly highlighted: a) what I saw and what I observed; b) what was done independently. The protocols are signed either by the lecturer of the department, or by the paramedic/doctor with whom the student worked directly.

- 4) completed medical documentation of an outpatient clinic doctor

- 5) Report on the conducted practice.

The report includes the number of independent practical work (manipulations) carried out during the entire practice period, as provided for in the practice program.

- 6) Characteristics

The following is placed on the characteristic:

- Signature of the head of practice from the medical organization,
- The stamp of the medical organization.

The diary is provided in a paper version.
