

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**THE PROCEDURE FOR**

at the Department of General Hygiene and Ecology of the N. P. Grigorenko Institute of Public  
Health

2025-2026 academic year

## 1. General provisions

1.1. This Procedure for conducting intermediate certification of students at the Department of General Hygiene and Ecology of the N. P. Grigorenko Institute of Public Health of the Volgograd State Medical University of the Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation in *the winter/summer* test and examination session of the 2025-2026 academic year (hereinafter referred to as the Procedure, Intermediate Certification - IC) was developed in order to regulate the conduct of intermediate certification (specialty, Bachelor's degree, Master's degree) at the Department of General Hygiene and Ecology of the N. P. Grigorenko Institute of Public Health of the Volgograd State Medical University of the Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation in the 2025-2026 academic year.

1.2. The Procedure clarifies and details the requirements of the Regulations for conducting intermediate certification of students in the Volgograd State Medical University of the Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation in its current version regarding organizational issues of the IC, taking into account the cathedral specifics and features of the implemented disciplines/practices.

1.3. The Procedure is brought to the attention of students no later than 1 month before the start of the IC by posting these documents on the cathedral page of the site.

1.4. The Procedure comes into force instead of the previous version of a similar document and is valid for the 2025-2026 academic year.

## 2. Organizational issues of the IC

2.1. The date of conducting the IC in specific disciplines/practices implemented at the department is determined by the schedule of the Credit and examination session approved by the order of the Vice-rector for Educational Activities. The time of the IC is determined by the IC schedule approved by the head of the Department. The date and time of the consultation (for the exam) is determined by the schedule of pre-examination consultations approved by the department.

2.2. The order of the IC, the cathedral schedule of the IC, the schedule of pre-examination consultations are brought to the attention of students by posting these documents on the cathedral page of the site, students are familiarized with the documents at least 1 month before the start of the IC.

2.3. The grade for the IC in points according to the 100-point system, as well as the final grade for the discipline/practice (according to the 5-point system for the exam, credit with an assessment; according to the system "credited", "not credited" for the credit) are brought to the student upon the fact of his oral answer or upon verification of the completed task. they will receive a written task within the established time frame.

2.4. The final assessment in the discipline / practice is entered in the student's credit book, the credit and examination list and the electronic information and educational environment of the Volgograd State Medical University of the Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation. However, for grades based on the 5-point system, only the verbal equivalent of the grade ("excellent", "good", "satisfactory", "unsatisfactory") is entered, and not the numerical values of the points.(5, 4, 3, 2).

2.5. Based on the results of the IC, the student has the right to appeal.

2.6. Students who have not passed the IC are assigned a re-certification, according to local acts of the Volgograd State Medical University of the Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation and the approved schedule of retakes.

## 3. Procedure for conducting a full-time IC

3.1. The Department of General Hygiene and Ecology of the N. P. Grigorenko Institute of Public Health of the Volgograd State Medical University of the Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation conducts full-time IC in the following disciplines/practices:

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3.2. IC in the subjects taught at the department is conducted full-time. At the same time, the student chooses a ticket containing practice-oriented tasks and situational tasks on various topics of the discipline, solves them on paper, followed by an oral answer to the examiner. Students are not allowed to use any means of communication. Students are allowed to use a simple calculator. Students must wear lab coats and a change of shoes during the IC. The total preparation and response time is up to 70 minutes (up to 10 minutes – identification of the individual and issuing a ticket at the beginning of the IC; up to 30 minutes-writing a plan (abstract) response time and up to 30 minutes. to an oral response).

3.3. In case of establishing restrictive measures in case of unfavorable sanitary and epidemiological situation, the IC in full-time format is carried out in compliance with the following sanitary and hygienic requirements:

carrying out cleaning of premises with the use of disinfectants according to the virus mode before receiving IC, including the treatment of all contact surfaces in public areas (door handles, switches, handrails, handrails, table surfaces, etc.); if the duration of IC is more than 4 hours – repeated treatment of contact surfaces;

providing conditions for hygienic hand treatment with antiseptic agents in the lobby at the entrance to the building where IC is conducted, in sanitary units, as well as ensuring the constant availability of hand washing products, antiseptic hand treatment products in bathrooms;

mandatory thermometry in a non-contact way at the entrance to the building/department where IC takes place;

non-admission to the IC of persons with an elevated body temperature (above 37<sup>0</sup>C) and signs of acute respiratory viral infections (cough, rhinorrhea, sneezing, etc.). In this case, the student is given a failure to appear for a valid reason (which is made a corresponding entry in the IC's statement) and the terms of his IC are postponed to another time during the Credit and examination period. sessions, and information about the new dates of the IC is brought to the student's attention no later than 3 business days before its start;

prevention of congestion of students (including in halls and corridors before the start of the IC), control of compliance with social distance, including when seating in the classroom for the IC;

the presence of properly worn personal respiratory protection equipment on all IC participants (students, teachers, support staff);

organization of centralized collection of used disposable masks after receiving IC with their packaging in plastic bags before placing them in waste collection containers.

#### 4. Procedure for conducting IC with the use of DLT

4.1. The Department of General Hygiene and Ecology of the N. P. Grigorenko Institute of Public Health of the Volgograd State Medical University of the Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation conducts IC with the use of DLT (Distant Learning Technologies) in the following disciplines/practices:

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4.2. Credit in the discipline "Manager's labor Physiology" for students of the Bachelor's degree program 38.03.02 Management, orientation (profile) Management in healthcare is carried out in a remote form with the use of DLT. At the same time, the student enters the corresponding course on the electronic information and educational portal, opens the section "Intermediate Certification (credit)", receives an individual version of tasks randomly selected from the fund of assessment tools of the discipline and performs them on paper with subsequent scanning and posting on the DEIP (Digital Educational and Information Portal) and then an oral answer to the examiner. Students are allowed to use a simple calculator. Total preparation and response time – up to 90 minutes (up to 10 minutes – identification of the individual and compliance with technical requirements at the beginning of the course; up to 30 minutes-writing a plan (abstract) up to 20 minutes – scanning/photographing the student's response plan and sending it for verification on the DEIP and up to 30 minutes. to an oral response).
